Architectural Control Committee (ACC) Guidelines 2021 (Attached) - In May 2021, the Board notified residents of the revised and consolidated overall General LITW Policies. In that same spirit of communication, the current ACC Committee has consolidated and simplified some of the more commonly used alterations and LITW Covenant violations frequently observed in the LITW community. The ACC Guidelines 2021 are a reference to assist all owners/residents prior to initiating outdoor home changes/projects. FRONT GATE NEWS

<u>3rd Quarter Long Term Passes</u> – Please remember to renew your long-term passes with the front gate by 30th of June.

<u>Continuing Vendor/Guest Issues at Front Gate</u> - Please remember to call in any vendor/contractor or guest with the name, date and time of entry to LITW. This assists the front gate access control personnel to quickly confirm your vendor/guest and allow entry. There have been several denials of entries due to residents not contacting the front gate with the proper information. In addition, just a reminder, that any vendor arriving to LITW with a pet will also be denied entry with any animal. This is safety protocol for LITW residents and vendors pets' alike. The LITW Access Control personnel continue to make exemplary efforts in verifying that proper notice to the front gate has been initiated by residents and would like to thank residents in advance for the notification.

<u>Resident Entertaining</u> – A reminder that as we move into fun summer activities, please don't forget to call in or deliver your list of guest names to the front gate prior to your event.

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<u>Another Slow Down Reminder</u> – **Good News!** The newly installed resident only front gate entry withstood the first summer downpour with just one minor adjustment. **Bad News!** Many residents are practicing their latent Hot-Rod Speedway skills while driving through the gate. **Please slow down**. The first curve on River Birch subsequent to resident entry gate has been designated as a 20 MPH curve for a reason. ---SAFETY---


